

## COVID-19 SECURE INFORMATION FOR HIRERS AND USERS

As of 9 August 2021 Scotland is moving beyond the Protection Levels system.

The Board of Trustees (the Board) has therefore agreed adjustments to the arrangements put in place in June 2021 in accordance with guidance set out in *Coronavirus (COVID-19): staying safe and protecting others (6 August 2021)*- <https://www.gov.scot/publications/coronavirus-covid-19-staying-safe-and-protecting-others/>

As of 16 August 2021 therefore all rooms including the kitchen are available for use.

We all have a responsibility to keep our local community safe and the best way to do this to work together to understand and comply with our obligations. Hirers/users are thus required to comply with Scottish Government regulations and guidance and all other guidance applicable to their sector/activity in place at the time of hire/use.

It is for hirers/users to ensure they are aware of and familiarise themselves with up to date regulations and guidance.

Please remember at all times that

- 1 no-one should enter the Centre if you or anyone in your household has COVID-19 symptoms in the last 7 days
- 2 if you develop COVID-19 symptoms within 7 days of visiting the Centre
  - (a) comply with Test and Protect procedures
  - (b) alert BOTH the organiser of the event/activity you attended AND the Secretary on 07 768 143 111.
- 3 Unless exempt for specific circumstances, the law says you must wear a face covering in most indoor public places including public transport.
- 4 Although no longer a legal requirement everyone should still continue to be aware of physical distancing and maintain high standards of hand, face and respiratory hygiene practices and keep confined and/or busy spaces well ventilated.
